## The DATE in English

There are two ways of saying the date in English.

## Written English

**March 7**

MONTH + DAY

**7<sup>th</sup> March**

DAY + MONTH

## Spoken English

**March seventh**Even if the *-th* isn't written,  
an ordinal number is still said.**The seventh of March**

## Numbers

**3 / 7 / 17**

MONTH / DAY / YEAR

**7 / 3 / 17**

DAY / MONTH / YEAR

## Days

We always use  
**ordinal numbers**  
for the date in  
spoken English.

- 1<sup>st</sup> first
- 2<sup>nd</sup> second
- 3<sup>rd</sup> third
- 4<sup>th</sup> fourth
- 5<sup>th</sup> fifth
- 6<sup>th</sup> sixth
- 7<sup>th</sup> seventh
- 8<sup>th</sup> eighth
- 9<sup>th</sup> ninth
- 10<sup>th</sup> tenth

## Months

Months always start  
with capital letters.august

August



What day is this?

**3 / 5 / 18**

March 5, 2018

3<sup>rd</sup> May 2018

Big difference!

## Years

Years are normally  
divided into two parts.\***1984**

nineteen eighty-four

1652 sixteen fifty-two

1941 nineteen forty-one

2017 twenty seventeen

\* **Exception:** For the years from  
2000 to 2010, we normally say  
**two thousand and + number.**

2006 two thousand and six

We normally add a <sup>TH</sup> to the end of a cardinal number to make it an ordinal number. Be careful of the spelling exceptions below:

1 <sup>st</sup> first	11 <sup>th</sup> eleventh	21 <sup>st</sup> twenty-first
2 <sup>nd</sup> second	12 <sup>th</sup> twelfth	22 <sup>nd</sup> twenty-second
3 <sup>rd</sup> third	13 <sup>th</sup> thirteenth	23 <sup>rd</sup> twenty-third
4 <sup>th</sup> fourth	14 <sup>th</sup> fourteenth	24 <sup>th</sup> twenty-fourth

**DATES:** Her birthday is on the *29th*.

**CENTURIES:** Shakespeare was born in the *16th* century.

**SEQUENCE/ORDER:** My team came *second* in the league.

**FLOORS OF A BUILDING:** His office is on the *tenth* floor.

## DAYS – MONTHS – DATES – ORDINAL NUMEBRS

### DATE OF BIRTH

MY BIRTHDAY IS ON THE THIRD OF DECEMBER 1991 = MY BIRTHDAY IS ON 3<sup>rd</sup> DECEMBER 1991

MY BIRTHDAY IS ON DECEMBER 3<sup>rd</sup> 1991 = MY BIRTHDAY IS ON DECEMBER THE THIRD 1991
