
PREPOSITIONS OF PLACE



PREPOSITIONS OF TIME

IN + 5 minutes, November, 2021, the morning/afternoon/evening...

Ex:

- The lesson starts in 5 minutes
- The Christmas holidays are in December
- I drink coffee in the morning/afternoon/evening

AT + 6.00 pm, the weekend, midday, midnight

Ex:

- The lesson is at 6.00 pm
- I go out at the weekend
- I have coffee break at midday

ON + Monday, December 3rd (birthday)

Ex:

- My English lesson is on Monday
- My birthday is on December 3rd
- Christmas is on December 25th

FROMTO... = From 9.00 am to 6.00 pm

Ex:

- The bank is open from 9.00 am to 3.00 pm
- The Christmas holidays are from December 23rd to January 6th
 - I go to school from Monday to Friday

IN + MESE

ON + GIORNO/ DATA

AT + ORA

FROM...TO.. PER I PERIODI DI TEMPO

THERE IS/THERE ARE....SOME/ANY

THERE IS= C'E'

THERE ARE = CI SONO

"THERE IS ONE LEMON IN THE FRIDGE"

(C'è un limone in frigo)

"THERE ARE TWO LEMONS IN THE FRIDGE"

(Ci sono due limoni in frigo)

THERE IS + SOME = c'è un po' di..

(nomi che non hanno il plurale, esempio milk, water, juice, money...)

"THERE IS SOME MILK IN THE FRIDGE"

(C'è un po' di latte in frigo)

THERE ARE + SOME...= Ci sono alcuni...(solo plurali, esempio cats, books..)

"THERE ARE SOME LEMONS IN THE FRIDGE"

(Ci sono alcuni limoni in frigo)

THERE ISN'T ANY/THERE AREN'T ANY = Non ce n'è/Non ci sono...

"THERE ISN'T ANY MILK IN THE FRIDGE"

THERE AREN'T ANY LEMONS IN THE FRIDGE

ANY nelle domande significa QUALCHE/ALCUNI

ARE THERE ANY LEMONS IN THE FRIDGE?

IS THERE ANY MILK IN THE FRIDGE?

QUANTITIES

MUCH + uncountable nouns (nomi che non hanno il plurare, ex: hair, sun, milk, water, food, money...)

MANY + countable nouns (nomi che hanno il plurale)

Ex: There are many books in the bookshelf

Ex: There isn't much milk left

A LOT OF: TANTO/I

You have a lot of books! / You have a lot of milk.

SOME: QUALCHE – UN PO'

Ex: I have got some milk in the fridge // I have got some pens here.

ANY: NESSUNO / QUALCHE (per le domande)

Ex: I haven't got any pen.

Ex: have you got any pens?

(A) FEW: POCO/POCHI (countable nouns)

Ex: I have got a few friends

(A) LITTLE: POCO/POCHI (uncountable nouns)

Ex: I have got little money. Ex: Have you got milk? – Just a little.
